Letter of Commitment - Appropriate use of Virtual Machines

As a student in the Computer Science faculty, I declare the following regarding the use of the virtual machine provided to me by the Department of the Computer Science (hereafter, "the VM"):

1. I am accountable for all installed programs on the VM I am given, and commit not to install any illegal software.
2. I commit not remove/add users on the VM.
3. I commit not to change the operating system that is installed on the VM.
4. I commit not to change the name of the VM.
5. I commit not to change the network settings of the VM.
6. I am aware that as a consequence of any of the following operations I might not be able to connect with the VM:
 - Using the "halt" or "shutdown" Linux commands.
 - Stopping a running system service.
7. I am aware the IT staff may disconnect the VM from the internet or shut it down in any one of the following cases:
 - The VM is suspected to be a source of a computer crime.
 - The VM is infected with a computer virus.
 - The VM is not up to date with latest security updates.
 - Any of the above conditions is not fulfilled.
8. I am aware the VM is subject to inspection by the IT staff at any time to check whether the above conditions are being fulfilled.
